ABSTINENCE is a penitential practice consisting of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence. In addition to abstinence, fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18-59 years (inclusive). On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

Note: Those who are unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.

MEMORIAL CROSSES TO HONOR DECEASED VETERANS

The Catholic War Veterans (Post 1943) will again be placing Memorial Crosses in the Catholic Cemetery at 1720 Wheaton St., Savannah, GA. Each Cross bears a Veteran's name, branch of service and conflict. The Crosses will be put in place on 22 May and will remain through Memorial Day. If you would like to honor a deceased Veteran in this manner, request forms are available in the Church office, or contact Bart Picasso, (912) 856-3512, bart.picasso@comcast.net, by 20 April. There is a one-time fee of \$30 for supplies. The Crosses will continue to be maintained and placed in the Cemetery each year thereafter.
